National Intelligence Budget Planning in Argentina

Abstract

The approval of Law N° 25.520: National Intelligence at the end of 2001 broke away from a tradition of secrecy regulating intelligence activities. The new law obliged the inclusion of the total amount of funds allocated to finance the intelligence system into the National Budget through the creation of a new budget category. This paper looks into the allocation of intelligence funds since the approval of the aforementioned to analyze budget planning. The analysis shows continuous increases in funding the Criminal Intelligence Subsystem to the detriment of the Federal Intelligence Agency (AFI, ex SI) and the Military Strategic Intelligence Subsystem.
